



ABOUT LAWRENCE J-P

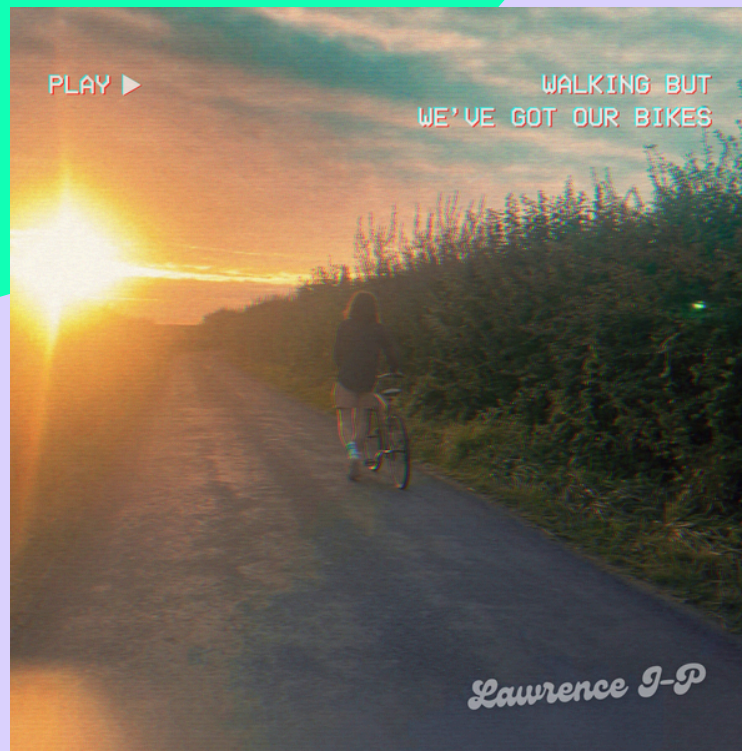

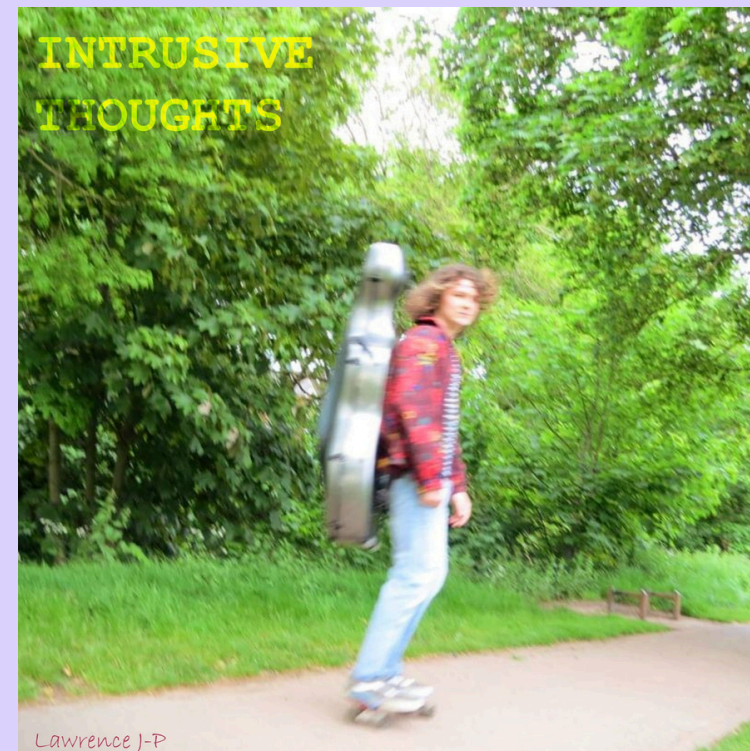
